Terms and Conditions

The theme this year is flora (in this case flowers) and fauna (animals), or both. Other subjects may be in the work, but an animal or a flower must be featured. The quality of the work will take precedence over the subject. Any original representational two dimensional work in oil, acrylic, watercolor, ink, pencil, or scratch board, and wall-mounted or framed sculpture relief under 40 lbs will

be considered. **No All Works photography or must be hand prints delivered** will be accepted. All Works must be framed; outer dimensions for each entry must not exceed 28 x 34 inches. **Work must not infringe on any copyright.**

Acceptance notification— **April 29-** Artists will be notified by email of their accepted work. Notification by mail only if artist includes a self-addressed stamped postcard with entry.

Work must be **HAND DELIVERED** to the Schuler School. Work must be **READY TO HANG** and labeled with name, title, price. **No work will be return shipped.**

Delivery Deadline - May 7th, 2011,
9am-1 pm or by appointment.

Pick up – May 21-22 10am-6pm.

Entry Requirements

SCREENING BY DIGITAL IMAGES ONLY

ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED AS JPG FILES ON DISK

JPEG files should be a minimum size of 1MB, maximum 3MB, @ 300dpi

Disk should be labeled with the Artist's name, email address, and the name "Flora and Fauna Show".

If more than one piece is entered, all entries must be on the same disk. The file name of each entry must correspond to the entry form with artist's name, title, and the letters A,B, or C.

Entries must be postmarked no later than **April 25, 2011.** Send check, entry form, CD, and self-addressed stamped return postcard (if you wish to be notified by mail of acceptance)
