Any original representational sculpture or two dimensional work in oil, acrylic, watercolor, ink, pencil, scratchboard, and wall-mounted or framed sculpture relief under 40

lbs. will be considered. **No photography or prints** will be accepted. *Framed dimensions for each entry must not exceed 28 x 34 inches. Work must not infringe on any copyright.*

Artists will be notified by email if for some reason, such as size, cost, or subject, a piece is rejected.

All work must be for sale at a price intended to encourage actual purchase

Work HAND DELIVERED to the Schuler School must be **READY TO HANG** and labeled with your name, title, price.

Delivery Deadline on or before April 4, 9am-2pm or by appointment.

Pick up – April 18, 10am-2pm or by appointment.

SCREENING BY DIGITAL IMAGES ONLY

Entries must be submitted as jpg files on **the Schuler Website, www.schulerschool.com(instructions are on the website)** or by email to **schulershow@gmail.com**. JPG files should be a minimum size of 1MB, maximum 3MB, @ 300dpi

Each Entry image must be labeled to correspond to the entry form with artist’s name, title, price, size and medium.
